MINIMIZING YOUR OUT OF POCKET COSTS FOR CERTAIN SURGERIES AND PROCEDURES

Your out of pocket limits apply for certain non-emergency surgeries and **ONLY** when performed at selected network facilities. Before scheduling your procedure or surgery, discuss these benefit limitations with your provider to ensure your costs do not exceed the out of pocket limits of your plan. *Butte County facilities are listed below; call (800) 564-7475 for other covered facilities near you.*

Benefits for these non-emergency surgeries are restricted to facilities with the distinctions listed below. *Certain exceptions apply.*

There are no benefit restrictions when these procedures are performed at network Ambulatory Surgery Centers (ASC), such as the facilities listed below. At other facilities, you will be responsible for facility charges above these amounts and beyond your plan’s out of pocket maximum. Charges by your network doctor or surgeon performing the procedure/surgery will not exceed your out pocket maximum. *Certain exceptions apply; contact Member Services at 800-564-7475 for assistance.*
